

Spiritual Life Week

Spring semester's Spiritual Life Week will take place April 2-8, 2017, with **Ohio Conference Pastor Paula Snyder Belousek** of Salem Mennonite Church in Elida, Ohio, leading events.

Mennonite minister and author **Todd Wynward** led a week-long series of activities during fall semester's Spiritual Life Week, Nov. 6-12, 2016. Events focused on Isaiah 40:3 "A voice of one calling: 'In the wilderness prepare the way for the Lord; make straight in the desert a highway for our God.' "

Humanizing Martyrdom

During the month of November, an exhibit and events series featured Jan Luyken's original copper etching plate illustrating the story of Jacques D'Auchy in the 1865 "Martyrs Mirror." Events included a Forum presentation by **Dr. David Weaver-Zercher**, professor of American religious history at Messiah College, and a readers theatre presentation written, directed and performed by Bluffton University faculty, staff and students.
