

Deficit continues, but giving in December is up

Giving to the Ohio Conference in December was stronger than in any other month of the 2016-17 fiscal year, according to figures provided by Conference Financial Coordinator Stan Helmuth.

Total receipts for the month of December were \$42,212, including \$8,950 in yearend giving from individuals in response to an appeal from Conference



leadership. Our thanks go out to all those individuals who contributed.

Congregational giving in December totaled \$33,250, the largest monthly amount for the fiscal year so far.

Total expenses for the month were \$29,341, leaving an operating surplus of \$12,871 for the month. However, the Conference is still experiencing a deficit for this fiscal year. As of Dec. 31, the Conference's operating balance was -\$14,164. The Conference fiscal year ends March 31, 2017.

Summer Youth Program applications accepted

The Summer Youth Program (SYP) of Mennonite Disaster Service is now accepting applications. The SYP is a weeklong summer service experience designed for youth and their sponsors to put hands and feet to the gospel by serving others. SYP work is focused on cleanup, disaster mitigation, and repairing homes. The 2017 SYP locations are Detroit, Michigan; Pine Ridge, South Dakota; and southern Ontario, Canada.
