Beginning this fall, Interim Regional Pastor Cliff Brubaker has been traveling around the Ohio Conference, meeting with leaders from individual congregations for a time of conversation. His goal is to meet with leaders from each Ohio Conference congregation.

One purpose of these conversations is to identify ways to strengthen the relationships between the congregations and the Conference, as well as strengthening relationships between congregations. Another purpose is to

gather information to help the Ohio Conference Leadership Team plan for the 2017 Annual Conference Assembly and for the future direction of the Ohio Conference.

Assisting Cliff Brubaker in this task is his wife, Marilyn Grasse-Brubaker, who is serving as "scribe" for many of these conversations.

As of mid-December, Cliff has met with congregational leaders of 24 congregations in the Ohio Conference.



Conference deficit increases in November

Ohio Conference's financial deficit increased during the month of November, according to figures provided by Ohio Conference Financial Coordinator Stan Helmuth. Receipts for the month were \$21,055, and expenses totaled \$22,562, resulting in a net loss of -\$1,507 for the month of November.

For the first eight months of the fiscal year, receipts have totaled \$174,781, and expenses have totaled



\$201,817, resulting in an operating balance of -\$27,036. The Ohio Conference fiscal year ends March 31, 2017.
