Cliff Brubaker accepts additional assignment

The Ohio Conference Leadership Team has invited Interim Regional Pastor Cliff Brubaker to work with the Conference on a full-time basis, beginning Sept. 18. Since April he has been serving as regional pastor on a half-time basis.

This additional half-time assignment will have two areas of focus:

- Working with the continuing process of the Ohio Conference Year of Covenant
- Identifying and implementing ways to build and/or rebuild trust between congregations and the Conference, congregations and other congregations, and pastors with other pastors

This additional half-time position is an interim position and will extend through April 1, 2017. Cliff's half-time interim position as regional pastor in the western part of the Conference also extends through that date. More information about this assignment will be forthcoming.

Funding for this additional half-time position will come from the money which had been designated for George O'Reilly's position as Year of Covenant Facilitator. (Those funds are coming from the Conference's Capacity Building Fund rather than the 2016-17 spending plan.) George O'Reilly has begun a full-time position at First Mennonite Church in Bluffton, and he is continuing as a consultant for the Year of Covenant on a limited basis.

In addition to the mission emphasis, each meeting will include a brief time of reporting from the Ohio Conference Leadership Team. This last portion of the meeting is especially important for delegates to Annual Conference Assembly, but all participants are invited to stay for the business portion of the meeting.

Deficit increases slightly in August

Ohio Conference's financial deficit increased slightly during Au-

gust. Receipts for the month totaled \$26,465, including \$26,182 in congregational giving. Expenses for the month were \$27,540, resulting in a net income of -\$1,075 for the month.



For the first five months of the fiscal year, receipts have to-

taled \$97,518, and expenses have totaled \$127,635, resulting in an operating balance of -\$30,117.

So far, giving to the Conference in 2016-17 is significantly less than during 2015-16. By the end of August 2015, the Conference had received \$124,164, compared with the \$97,518 received during the first five months of 2016-17. Even so, because of cuts in the spending plan, the deficit is not as great as it was at this time last year. At the end of August 2015, the Conference's operating balance was -\$77,229.

Retreat registration deadline extended

The registration deadline for the Ohio Conference Youth Worker Retreat has been extended until **Friday, Sept. 16**. The retreat will take place Sept. 30-Oct. 1 at Camp Luz in Kidron.

Featured speakers will be Dr. Randy Keeler, associate professor of religion at Bluffton University; and Brent Lacey, author of the book *Rural Youth Ministry: Thrive Where You're Planted*.

Naomi Engle, co-pastor of West Clinton Mennonite Church in Wauseon, is scheduled for surgery Thursday, Sept. 15, at 2 p.m. in Toledo. Doctors expect she will be in ICU for a day, and perhaps several more days in regular care as she recovers. It will take about a week to get pathology reports back.
