The first two pages contain a service for congregational use. The next page is for small group use. And the last page, for personal use.



Prayer of Confession (together)

[We approach God as sinners; just as Paul considered himself the foremost, so are we all.] Create in me a clean heart, O God, and put a new and right spirit within me. Do not cast me away from your presence, and do not take your Holy Spirit from me. Restore to me the joy of your salvation, and sustain in me a willing spirit. (Psalm 51:10-12)

Silent Prayers of Confession

Scripture Romans 8:26-27 (read by leader)

Prayer of Intercession/Petition (together)

Give us discerning minds, oh Lord; eyes to see, ears to hear, and hearts that are open Help us to let go of our need to control the situation Help us to remember those who have been hurt or silenced and those who have been called to leadership roles Help us to pray "Your will be done, not mine".

Silent Prayers of intercession/Petition

[invite group to light a candle as a symbol of their affirmation of faith]

Song (optional) (song may be sung or recorded) HWB 545 "Be Thou My Vision"

Confession [Invite group to speak aloud their confessions of ways we are complacent, judgmental, unforgiving, our need to control, our fears, our doubts, etc.]

Scripture Romans 8:26-27 (read by leader)

Candle Lighting/Silence/Supplications

[invite group to offer prayers of supplication and intercession. Please approach God as the sinners that we are, in a posture of oneness with those for whom we pray.] [invite group to light a candle/s as a symbol of their trust in God to do what is right, good and just]

Song (optional) (song may be sung or recorded) StJ 98 "All Will be Well"

Circle of Gratitude [invite group to stand, hold hands (optional), and offer a word of gratitude for what God has done, is doing, and will do in the situation between Ohio Conference and Mountain States Conference.]

Benediction (by leader)

Go in the peace and light of Christ Jesus who, in the hours before his death, prayed for our unity through love. May your will be done in us and through us.

Invocation

Supplication

and yet, you pray within me prayers too deep for words.

I offer my heart and all that is in it, to you.

Do with it as you will,

Grant me an open heart and a willing spirit,

that I might approach life in a posture of gratitude and love.

Open Prayer/Silence

(if you are not used to silence, begin slowly. Try 5 minutes, increasing to 15-20 minutes of silence, with an open heart and listening ears. Allow the Holy Spirit to pray within you.)

Benediction

May the God of hope fill me with all joy and peace in believing so that I may abound in hope by the power of the Holy Spirit. Amen
