Resource Team Process

The Coordinator of Volunteers (formerly known as the Resource Team Coordinator) serves as the liaison between the Ministry Development Team and the Resource Teams of the Conference.

A Resource Team may be formed in two ways. The MDT may request a Resource Team be formed to respond to a need or dream within the Conference. Constituents may also submit requests for a resource team.

While technological advances allow quick communication, the Conference values community and relationships. The Coordinator is available to travel and meet with Resource Teams or Team Leaders as needed.

- 1. Resource Team Request is submitted via online form.
- 2. Coordinator communicates with key leaders of Resource Team.
- 3. MDT approves Resource Team.
 - a. Letter of welcome
 - b. Job description of Coordinator
 - c. Form II (funding request form)
- 4. Coordinator works with Resource Team to develop goals and timeline.
- 5. Team communicates regularly with the Coordinator until project is complete.
