Certainty

Right and wrong are easily determined Clarity is desirable and achievable Scripture is easily understood and consistently clear

Mystery

Life is much larger and more complex than we can determine
God is much larger and more complex than we can fully understand
Scripture has one Holy Spirit inspiring many different writers that give us books of the
Bible that are in dialogue with one another; discernment is an on-going task

Missional invitation — Come! We are seeking the Way, the Truth, and the Life; Christ is showing us how to live, but we aren't very good at it yet; we are still trying and we invite you to join us; perhaps you can help us see our blind spots and together we can follow more completely

How each (in the extreme) sees the other

Mystery sees Certainty — arrogant, come and join us, become like us Certainty sees Mystery — wishy washy, come and be who you want to be
