

Giving to Conference is lower in April

Ohio Conference is beginning its 2018-19 fiscal year with a deficit, according to figures provided by Financial Coordinator Stan Helmuth. Receipts for the month of April totaled just \$12,095, including \$11,000 in giving from congregations. Expenses for the month totaled \$23,782, resulting in an operating balance of -\$11,687 for the month. Even so, expenses were well below the amount budgeted for the month, \$31,679.

Receipts for April were lower than they were in the last few months of the 2017-18 fiscal year. Please see the accompanying chart for details.
