### **WORKSHOPS**

#### Worship Leading - Wanda Stopher

"Worship is much more than something Christians attend on Sunday morning—it is something pilgrims make together." This quote comes from Diana Butler Bass in her book, Christianity for the Rest of Us. In this participatory workshop we'll explore together what it means to lead worship as "something pilgrims make together" as well as the implications for scripture in worship...

## The Lectionary & Liturgical Calendar: Season of Change in the Christian Year - Dale Kern & Jim Nathan:

From the time of Constantine and the Creeds, comes also the beginnings of the Ordo, or the Orders of Worship. Today, these practices continue in the use of the Lectionary, the Book of Common Prayer and the Liturgical Calendar. Come see how these tools of the Church are already part of your practices of worship, and how they can be re-discovered for new opportunities.

#### Hymn Leading 101 - Duane Beck & Anita Roth

This session is intended to be a practical, "hands-on" workshop, geared toward beginners--through experienced hymn leaders are welcome. Also welcome are folks who just want to come sing with us. Topics will include selecting hymns, ideas for leading with and without accompaniment, and conducting basics (giving the starting pitch, simple conducting gestures, and conducting in two and three). We will encourage participants to ask questions and practice skills as time allows.

Hymn Leading 102 - Duane Beck & Anita Roth: This session will serve as a follow-up to the first session, but beginners and experienced leaders alike are welcome, as well as people who just want to sing. We will address organization of hymnals, how to use resources provided in the hymnal as well as additional resources, and share ideas for introducing and teaching new hymns. We will incorporate a variety of hymn styles as we explore and discuss effective hymn leading.

Visual Art in Worship - Connie Nofziger & Anita Sauder: Practical ideas and inspiration to enhance your church's visual worship. Learn how use of color, design, natural elements, and still life arrangements, as creative tools that support and enhance the worship theme and bring glory to God.

Writing Words for Worship: Rachel Miller Jacobs: This hands-on workshop will both lay out some principles for writing words for public worship and provide time do some writing. Styles of worship words will include prayer, calls to worship, and benedictions; the process and practice could apply as well to any other worship words. Both newcomers to writing worship words and experienced writers are welcome; paper and writing implements will be provided. Come prepared to experiment together and learn from each other. Limited to 10 people per session.
