The surgery went well, and Cliff was able to go home from the hospital on Sunday, Oct. 28. He is recovering at home, and reports, "I am walking every day, and it goes better each day. It is considerably easier for me to walk now than prior to surgery."

Cliff also reports that at his first post-surgery doctor appointment, the surgeon was pleased with how things are progressing. Cliff will be doing cardiac rehab three days a week, and he plans to resume his work for the Ohio Conference beginning in January.
