

Deficit increases during September

Giving to the Ohio Conference dropped during September, according to figures provided by Financial Coordinator Stan Helmuth. Receipts for September were \$17,699, down from the \$24,910 received in August.

Expenses for September totaled \$26,288, resulting in a deficit of \$8,589 for the month.

As of Sept. 30, the Conference's operating balance for the 2020-21 fiscal year was -\$21,304. The Conference's fiscal year ends March 31, 2021.



Video training available for abuse prevention

The Dove's Nest, an organization committed to empowering faith communities to keep children and youth safe from abuse in their churches, homes and communities, has a new video resource available.
