

Deficit increases slightly during October

Ohio Conference's deficit increased slightly during October, according to figures provided by Financial Coordinator Stan Helmuth.

Expenses for October totaled \$33,829, while receipts during the same time period were slightly lower, \$32,631. As a result, the Conference had a deficit of \$1,198 for the month. As of Oct. 31, the Conference showed a deficit of \$22,502 for the 2020-21 fiscal year.

Giving from congregations totaled \$30,700 in October, which was up considerably from the \$17,149 received from congregations during September. **We give thanks for your contributions**
