Foundations for Justice webinar series planned

As part of Ohio Conference's continuing education regarding anti-racism and intercultural competency, we are offering a threepart "Foundations for Justice Series," to be held virtually from 7 to 8:15 p.m. on three Thursdays — Oct. 20, Nov. 3, and Nov. 17.

Deficit increases slightly in August

Ohio Conference's financial deficit increased slightly during the month of August, according to figures provided by Financial Coordinator Stan Helmuth.

Receipts during August totaled \$26,449, including \$16,439 in giving from congregations. Expenses during August totaled \$27,350, resulting in a deficit of \$901 for the month.

As of Sept. 30, the Conference's operating balance for the 2022-23 fiscal year was -\$38,885. Even though the Conference continues to run a deficit, spending for this fiscal year is actually below the amount budgeted in the 2022-23 spending plan. The fiscal year ends March 31, 2023.
