



Giving to Conference drops in December

Giving to Ohio Conference was lower than average during December, resulting in a deficit of \$8,493 for the month.

According to figures provided by Stan Helmuth, Ohio Conference financial coordinator, receipts for the month totaled just \$16,028, including \$10,306 in congregational giving. Total expenses for the month were \$24,521.

As of Dec. 31, 2022, the Conference's operating balance was -\$55,452. The 2022-23 fiscal year ends March 31, 2023.
