Giving increases during December

Giving to Ohio Conference increased during December. Receipts for the month totaled \$31,476, including \$21,569 in congregational giving and \$9,885 in gifts from individuals. In contrast, receipts for the month of November totaled just \$20,839.

Expenses for December totaled \$30,612, resulting in a small surplus of \$864 for the month. As of Dec. 31, Ohio Conference’s operating balance for 2023-24 was -\$43,377. The Conference fiscal year ends March 31, 2024.
